RE: **“No Defense Action Indicated” (NDAI) Determination**

Dear Mr. Vincent:

As requested by the Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE), the Division of Environmental Response and Remediation (DERR) has reviewed the NDAI close out letters for the following Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS):

- **J08UT0750 Air Force Plant 81**
- **J08UT0929 Salt Lake City Airway Radio Station**

In order to make a determination as to whether or not the sites warrant an NDAI designation an extensive file review and site visit was conducted for each of the sites. Based upon our evaluation of the current information the DERR concurs with the ACOE that an NDAI designation is appropriate for these sites. If the DERR becomes aware in the future of releases or threatened releases of hazardous substances, hazardous waste, pollutants, or contaminants at these sites, and there is good cause to believe that the contamination is a result of past Department of Defense practices, then we would expect the ACOE to investigate and reevaluate the sites as part of its obligation and responsibility under the FUDS program.
